Ceský lid: Ethnological Journal (founded in 1891) is a well-established ethnological and anthropological journal in the Czech Republic that publishes original theoretical and research articles in all areas of ethnological and anthropological research. The journal is published four times a year by the Institute of Ethnology of the Czech Academy of Sciences and is indexed in prominent international databases centering on humanities and social sciences, including SCOPUS, ERIH - European Reference Index in Humanities, AIO - Anthropological Index Online, CEJSH - The Central European Journal of Social Science and Humanities) and also in on-line databases, such as EBSCOhost. All articles will be subject to double blind peer review process; upon positive evaluation they will be published within 6 months after they are submitted.

In order to guest-edit an upcoming thematic volume of the journal or to submit an individual article, please contact me during the conference or email me – most preferably by October 31, 2015 in order to ensure a 2016 publication date. I would be grateful to you if you could communicate this invitation to your colleagues who might be interested in publishing with us now or in the future.
